Into its 6th broadcast, Ren Ci Charity Show 2010 will once again shower the needy and the sick with ray of hope. Themed as 'Altruistic Love' ('大愛'), the coming event will showcase team efforts performing songs and acrobatic acts by local, overseas artistes and institutions. The Show hopes to raise **\$4 million**.

On the anchor fundraising event, Mr Chua Thian Poh, Chairman of Ren Ci Hospital & Medicare Centre said, "Ren Ci Charity Show has always been a platform where the public gets to understand the group of patients we are caring for. About Ren Ci Community Hospital

The Ren Ci Community Hospital is located at the heart of Singapore next to Tan Tock Seng Hospital. It commenced operations in December 2008 to provide rehabilitation and subacute care for patients who require a period of inpatient stay in a step-down setting before returning home.

The hospital has a total of 277 beds of which 123 are community hospital beds and 154 are chronic sick beds. In addition, the new hospital is equipped with a Rehabilitation Centre for both inpatients and outpatients, a TCM Clinic (operated by the Singapore Chung Hwa Medical Institution), and training facilities for caregivers, volunteers and staff.
