Community Care Manpower Development & Excellence Awards





Our staff flew Ren Ci's flag high at the Community Care Manpower Development & Excellence Awards 2024, with one of the highest numbers of recipients in the Community Care sector. Five staff received the Community Care Manpower Development Award (CCMDA) while 25 staff received the Individual Silver Community Care Excellence Award (CCEA). We also bagged 1 Individual Gold and one Team Gold Award!

Our Business Office Executive, Ms Ng Ling Ling, received her Individual Gold Award for her use of robotic process automation to automate daily time-consuming financial counselling documents, freeing up more time to spend on other tasks.

Our HERE Together team received a Team Gold Award for the programme which brings together multisensory, psychological and spiritual components to enhance the quality of life for persons who are bedbound and no longer verbally communicative. These awards recognise our efforts in continuously developing talent and strive for excellence.

UNLEASHING THE BEST IN YOU

Cheers rang out in the South Agora Hall of Republic Polytechnic, as the second edition of the Ren Ci Senior Sports Day was successfully held on 30 August 2024! This year, we partnered Republic Polytechnic to conduct our Senior Sports Day on their premises.

Nearly 140 seniors from all four Ren Ci Senior Care Centres were transported to Republic Polytechnic to compete in various sports that were adapted to their functional levels.

They competed in adaptive volleyball, baton relay race, shot put, ball escape and table hockey this year. Four of these games were brand new to our seniors, with table hockey making a repeat appearance due to its popularity. These games were carefully chosen to target not just physical strength, but also cognitive skills.

Our seniors' competitive spirits were ignited and their energy levels remained incredibly high through the entire day. Their joy and sense of accomplishment were palpable as they received their medals. Some of them even won multiple medals!

Forging New Parimerships

Ren Ci's mission is to partner the community to provide inclusive healthcare for quality and meaningful living. To this end, Ren Ci signed two Memoranda of Understanding (MOU) with APSN and Republic Polytechnic respectively.

APSN

The partnership with APSN reflects our ongoing commitment to inclusive hiring and providing meaningful employment opportunities for persons with special needs. Ren Ci will collaborate with APSN to offer employment opportunities for their beneficiaries through various initiatives, including the Apprenticeship Programme, contract work and support for APSN's alumni and student services.

We have students from APSN Delta School interning with Ren Ci @ Woodlands, and some of them are on track to be converted to full-time employees upon their graduation in January 2025! We look forward to welcoming them as official members of the Ren Ci family.







Republic Polytechnic

The MOU with Republic Polytechnic was signed as part of the Senior Sports Day festivities held on their premises. Almost 300 clients, next-of-kin, volunteers and staff witnessed Dr Jamie Mervyn Lim, CEO of Ren Ci, and Ms Jeanne Liew, Principal & CEO of Republic Polytechnic, sign the document.

This extends the MOU for another five years and will see both institutions exploring new avenues for partnership, including the co-development and delivery of courses, expanding volunteering opportunities, and providing job attachments for staff and students at Ren Ci Hospital.

Key Findings



As Singapore's population ages, palliative care becomes more important than ever as we care for individuals with life-limiting illnesses. To find out the key concerns of Singaporeans at end of life, Ren Ci reached out to almost 500 patients, residents, clients and next-of-kin with our palliative care awareness survey. Here are some of our key findings, which helped shape our 5-year strategic plan to grow our palliative care services.





Ren Ci Palliative Care Awareness Survey 2024

With an ageing population, emphasis on ageing in place and focus on palliative care, what are the key concerns of Singaporeans at end of life? Ren Ci reached out to almost 500 patients, residents, clients and their next-of-kin to find out.

Top Concerns

91%

Receiving emotional support



Adequate control of physical symptoms such as pain and shortness of breath



Awareness



About 3 in 5 respondents had heard of palliative care and felt they understood what it is < 1/3

Less than 1/3 of those surveyed were aware that therapists and pastoral team members are also involved in the provision of palliative care

Most respondents were unaware that therapists, social workers and pastoral team members work together to help persons at end-of-life express and process their emotions through stages such as denial, guilt, grief and finally acceptance as they come to terms with impending death

Good palliative care must be holistic, encompassing not just medical support but also psychological and spiritual support.
