

Conducting outcome measures and assessments

Keeping track of older adults' performance is important as it allows healthcare providers to pick up changes in functional status. Outcome measures are tools used to assess a person's current status. In this course, participants would learn and practice a series outcome: Patient Specific Functional Scale, Mini Mental State Examination, 5 times sit to stand, Timed up and Go, Gait Speed and EQ-5D.
