

## Advanced TA Skills – Geriatrics and Deconditioning

This course is designed to strengthen the competency of therapy assistants working with older adults experiencing functional decline. It would equip participants with knowledge of age-related physiological changes, common geriatric syndromes and the multifactorial causes of deconditioning. Through a series of interactive lectures, case based discussions and skills practice, participants will learn to support therapists in delivering rehabilitation, optimize engagement and contribute to care plan that improve function and quality of life for older adults.
